SENDING DISTRICTS IMPACTS

- The safety of students and staff must always be our highest priority.
- Staff members who have extenuating family, childcare, and medical circumstances struggled to return to work safely.

At this point, we cannot ensure enough coverage to also provide for adequate supervision of students, and we cannot open schools without certain staff members who are essential to doing so because of their roles.

UPDATES

- Implementing Initial **HCSS School Reopening Plans are postponed**. The situation will be reexamined on **the week of October 26**, two weeks before the first marking period ends.
- The goal is to implement **HCSS Hybrid In-Person** model in the Second Marking Period if the situation allows.
- All instruction will be delivered online through **Canvas Management System**
- **Vulnerable students** will be offered support and supervision in HCSS buildings four days in a week: **Mon, Tue, Thu, Fri**.

HOW VIRTUAL SCHOOL DIFFERENT?

LIVE

Classes will be streamed.

SYNCHRONIZED

Online students will join the classes with their In-School peers at the same time.

INTERACTIVE

Students will interact with their teachers and peers as needed.

SUPPORT

Students can receive extra support in Office hours.

ATTENDANCE

All online students are required to attend the classes starting 8:00am in the morning.

CURRICULUM

They will follow exactly same curriculum with Standards, Content, Assignments, and Assessments Hybrid program.

CANVAS

Online students will use CANVAS Learning Management System.

COLLEGE COUNSELING

Comprehensive College Counseling program will be provided online to all students.
